What to do today: Use <u>student</u> login to project what students are to do today.

- Find teacher's blog link from RC Homepage or Teacher's website (Important).
- Log in using the library number for password.
- Students click and read teacher's new post <u>under</u> "Recent Posts."
- Students respond in "Leave a Comment" box: Topic sentence, 3 details, closing sentence.
- Students submit comment (and are able to edit again if needed).
- Students will see each other's comments after teacher approves each comment.
- Students are able to edit their comments at home, but teacher will need to approve each time for comment to be viewed on Kidblog site.
